




Outer Circle: Exports of manufactured goods (2022) Centre Circle: GVA (2022) Inner Circle: R&D (2019)

# HOW THE UK COMPARES WITH OTHER COUNTRIES?

- UK 14th for export of goods 2.1% share of total merchandise exports
- UK 8th for import of goods
  3.1% share of total merchandise imports
- UK 2nd for service trade
  6.9% share of total services exports
- UK 6th for GDP 3.1trn US\$
- UK 31st for GDP per capita 45,850 US\$, current prices
