## LEAVING THE EU: EHS SUPPORT REACH AND UKCA

On 31st December 2020  
the UK will leave the European Union  
Single Market and Customs Union.

There are significant changes ahead in the way in  
which products are regulated in the UK and in the EU

### REACH - REGISTRATION OF CHEMICALS

From the 1st January 2021 the UK will transpose the existing EU regulation into UK law creating a UK market for chemicals. Existing downstream users now become 'importers' placing chemicals on the UK market IF those chemicals are imported into the UK from the EU.

If you are a UK manufacturer of chemicals and currently exporting your products to the EU you will need to transfer your registrations to an EU27 legal entity so that your EU registrations remain valid.

### UKCA - CONFORMANCE MARKING OF UK PRODUCTS

The UKCA (UK Conformity Assessed) marking is the new product marking that will be used for goods being placed on the market in Great Britain (England, Wales and Scotland). For goods placed on the Northern Ireland market, the CE marking or UK(NI) marking will apply.
