OPEN LETTER: BUSINESS AGAINST ANTISEMITISM

We, as leaders from across the UK business community, unreservedly condemn antisemitism in all its forms.

We champion inclusivity and stand against any and all forms of racism. Antisemitism is racism. There is no place for it in modern Britain.

The daily experience of antisemitism faced by Jewish people in our country is unacceptable and has reached a level that requires specific attention. No one should ever live in fear, but this has become the reality for many Jewish people in Britain.

Addressing antisemitism is a shared responsibility, and businesses have an important role to play in fostering safe, inclusive environments for everyone.

As business leaders we commit:

- **To lead:** Proactively speaking up against antisemitism.
- **To act:** Taking a zero-tolerance approach to tackle any incidents of antisemitism in our workplaces.
- **To improve understanding:** Including antisemitism as a form of racism in DEI programmes and other forms of internal training, helping people recognise how antisemitism can manifest not only through explicit abuse, but also through coded language, conspiratorial narratives and long-standing tropes.
- **To offer support:** Recognising the specific needs of Jewish colleagues at this time.

For the sake of our Jewish colleagues and friends, and for the health of our society as a whole, we urge all business leaders to join us.

Let's call out antisemitism and act together to play our part in ending it.
